

K-State at Salina Parking Committee Minutes  
November 13, 2007

Present: Scott Summers, Les Hannah, Joel Matthews (Chair), Dedra Francis, Hugh Irvin, and Charles Beckom, Capt.

Absent: Kimm Sanchez, TJ Hearn, Bill Badnaruk, Sam Smith, and Darwin Abbott

Joel called the meeting to order. He asked if there were any changes to the October minutes. Discussion was held regarding "summer suspension" wordage. It was decided to leave as it since it was for Minutes' purpose only. Dedra moved to approve and minutes and Les seconded. Motion carried.

Old Business:

Joel emailed the SGA President regarding the students' attendance to the meeting. Scott represents off campus students while Bill Badnaruk represents on campus, TJ SGA and Sam is at-large representative.

Scott volunteered to serve on the Finance Subcommittee. Since this is his first year Hugh asked what the responsibility of the subcommittees were. Joel informed him the subcommittees bring their suggestions/recommendations to the Parking Committee table to be considered. Joel asked the Rules & Regs subcommittee to work on the summer suspension of parking permit requirements. Charlie stated at present time residence halls students are allowed to park in Aero Center parking lot during the summer months because of the lower number of students on campus at that time.

Discussion was held regarding which permit a CFI/resident hall student should be issued. Les offered his opinion that it should be a student permit regardless of employment. He gave the example that grad students are considered as students. Hugh suggested a "rule for exception." Pat is to check if Manhattan campus has a permit that can be adopted for this purpose.

The number of motorcycle stalls will be looked at by the committee. The rise of fuel cost will probably mean a rise in the number of cycles on campus.

Hugh passed the information on to Dr. Barnhart regarding the second exit in the AC lot, street lights, and crosswalk.

New Business:

Hugh asked why there wasn't a stop sign coming out of the TAC parking lot when there was one across the street. His concern was that someone coming out of the TAC lot would hit someone coming out of the AC lot. He admitted that he doesn't always stop at that sign. It used to be a through street from Centennial to the flight line and KTI closed it at the Aero Center. In the fall of 1997 the old main gate was torn down and the entrance from Centennial to TAC and the east end of the parking lot were torn up. The chain across the west end of the TAC lot was removed to allow entry from Scanlan. Charlie informed him Facilities not Parking is responsible for the streets.

Pat asked for schedules to set up the Spring semester meetings. There will be no December meeting due to Finals.

Les moved to adjourn and Charlie seconded it. Meeting adjourned.
